Human Rights workshop and consultation to take place in UB

The UN Human Rights Council will hold a discussion and draw conclusions on the human rights situation in Mongolia on November 23 this year.

In connection with this event, the Center for Human Rights and Development in association with the Glob International NGO organized a workshop and consultation themed "NGO's preparation for the discussion of UN Human Rights Council". The workshop and consultation will take place in Ulaanbaatar on January 10-12, 2010, with the support from the Asia Forum.

Representatives of some 40 NGOs involved in the promotion and protection of human rights participated in this event. The discussion centered on the issues of exposing the real human rights situation in Mongolia to the international arena, and improving the human rights conditions there by making the victims' voices heard.

During the consultation, it was decided to set up a Forum of Mongolian NGO's to prepare the Human Rights Discussion. A decision was also made to prepare a Human Rights Report to be delivered to the Human Rights Discussion. Following issues are expected to be presented: reports on human rights situation in Mongolia; reports on human rights violation concerning an event of Jul.1, 2008; environment and mining; human rights; minorities' human rights situation; migrants' human rights situation and right of voting and be elected implementation issues.
